

## **RUSSIAN LANGUAGE - LANGUAGE OF PEACE, LANGUAGE OF LOVE!**

The Russian Language Centre of the National Migration Institute provides an opportunity for foreign citizens to learn Russian. Applicants can confirm this knowledge by passing the test and get state certificates, which are useful for living or working in the Russian Federation, or studying at Russian universities.

The Centre teaches Russian not only to adults but also to children and adolescents. Instruction is provided without using the pupil's mother tongue in a "deep dive" method in a remote form.

The teachers of the Institute are highly professional specialists with academic degrees and experience in working with foreign citizens.

The Centre's courses focus on:

### **COLLOQUIAL TRAINING COURSES FOR EVERYONE.**

Training hours up to 50.

These courses are aimed at:

- Beginners - Levels A1 and A2;
- Advanced - Levels B1, B2 and above.

#### **BEGINNERS' COURSE -150 HOURS.**

A1 (elementary level) 100-120 teaching hours.

A2 (basic level) 180-200 teaching hours.

#### **COURSE FOR CONTINUING - 450 hours.**

B1 (main occupation) 440-460 teaching hours.

B2 (advanced) - 720 teaching hours.

At the end of the course you can pass the test and get Certificates of the State standard of the Russian Federation levels B1, B2.

#### **CERTIFICATE B1**

It is compulsory for admission to higher education institutions of the Russian Federation.

This certificate shows that it is possible to carry out certain professional activities in communities where the working language is Russian.

#### **CERTIFICATE B2**

Indicates a fairly high level of communicative competence in all spheres of communication. This level allows the candidate to conduct professional activities in Russian as a specialist in humanitarian, engineering, natural science.

**PROFESSIONAL COURSE - 200 hours**

C1 (high level of proficiency) 280 teaching hours;

C2 (level of free ownership) 180 teaching hours.

At the end of the course you can pass the test and get state certificates of C1, C2 levels.

### **C1 CERTIFICATE**

Testifies to the high level of communicative competence in all spheres of communication, and allows to conduct professional activity in this language as a philologist, translator, editor, journalist, diplomat, manager, working in the Russian-speaking collective.

In the system of higher education in Russia, certification testing on the III level is carried out as a final state certification test (exam), giving the right to obtain a bachelor's, specialist and master's degree of the above specialties (except for specialists and masters of Russian philologists for whom this examination is an intermediate).

### **C2 CERTIFICATE**

It shows a high level of proficiency in Russian, close to the level of native speaker. The existence of this certificate is necessary for obtaining a diploma of a specialist and a master of philology-Russian, candidate of philological sciences, as well as a candidate of pedagogical sciences (in the specialty «Methods of teaching Russian as a foreign language») which gives the right to all kinds of teaching and research activities in the field of Russian language.

### **RUSSIAN LANGUAGE COURSES FOR CHILDREN**

1. Training courses for children and adolescents of the Russian language in preparation for levels A1, A2, at the end of which students can obtain appropriate certificates of the State model, allowing them to continue their education in the first year of any university in Russia in their chosen specialty.

2. Short-term courses to prepare children and adolescents for passing the A1, A2, B1 tests.

Upon completion of the courses, an examination is taken and a certificate is issued. At the end of the courses, testing can also be carried out with the subsequent issuance of the State certificate.

Certificate of the Russian language of the first certification level (B1) as a foreign gives the right to study at any university in Russia in Russian.
